

Will We See a Surge in Vaccine Mandates Now That the Pfizer Vaccine has been approved?

There's been a surge in vaccine mandates following the news of the FDA approval of the Covid-19 Pfizer vaccine.

In Israel, the majority of the population (60% including children) are fully vaccinated. Yet we're still seeing a large number of cases amongst the vaccinated. Around 60% of Israel's cases are among the vaccinated.

Iceland is recently vaccinated but is currently seeing more cases of covid than they ever have.

In a recent outbreak in Massachusetts, the CDC reports 74% of those infected were vaccinated.

The majority of the data suggests that the vaccine does not stop or slow the spread of the virus.
